Dear Resident,

As of March 28, 2022, Anthony Court will be included in the Township of Lyndhurst, Resident Permit Parking program. Starting this date, a permit will be required to park a vehicle on the street, between the hours of 10:00 PM and 3:00 AM, each night, including weekends and holidays.

These permits can be picked up at the Lyndhurst Police Traffic Bureau Monday through Friday between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM. You may also apply for a permit on-line by visiting [www.lyndhurstnj.org](http://www.lyndhurstnj.org).

To be eligible for a permit your driver's license and vehicle registration must have a Lyndhurst address. Please bring both items with you if you are applying in person or include copies if applying on-line. Permits are offered free of charge. One visitor permit per household will also be issued.
